- The peaks correlate with years when the society held a conference. The AEGC21 conference financials were added in 2022. Includes AEM23, MAG23.
- Publications are a good source of income. Although there was a low in 2021, there's an increase in 2022 (Sales of Doug Morrison's book). Then steady in 2023.
- The education category is picking up. The main income was from sponsorship received for the Camp for Applied Geophysics Excellence (CAGE).
- Other categories: Membership declined but is picking up again. Meetings and events also on a rise.
- Major decline for all categories in 2020-2021, some due to the Covid-19 pandemic.

#### Income 2012-2023

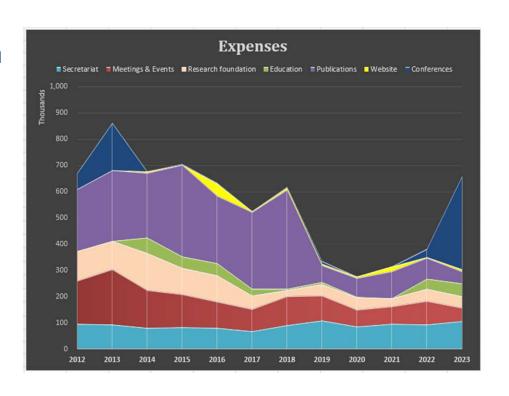






- Major expenses for conferences includes AEGC23, AEM23 and MAG23
- Education expenses have increased since 2021 because of the CAGE (accommodation, flights, meals).
- Research Foundation the ASEG continues to offer scholarships to university students for their Masters and PhD studies.
- In addition, part of the membership fees from the Corporate and Corporate Plus Sponsors are donated to the Research Foundation.
- Other expenses include Meetings and Events, Publications and Secretariat

### **Profit/Loss by Category 2012-2023**

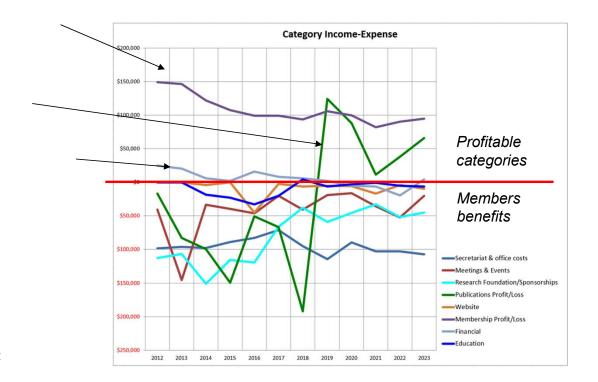
#### Profitable categories

- Membership over 700 members including 2 Corporate Plus and 7 Corporate members
- Publications 2019, new publisher, EG published online.
- Financials (interests received from Term deposits minus fees) have picked up since last year as interest rates increased.

#### Non-profitable categories

- Meetings and events (State meetings, travel to meetings, support to students) are run as a loss, a way for the ASEG to give back to the members
- Education mostly CAGE and sponsorship for career pathway workshops
- **Website** revamp for a better functionality
- Research Foundation donation to support students for geoscience education (Masters, PhD).
- Secretariat management of accounts and administration.

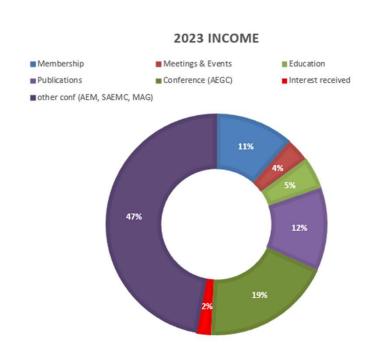

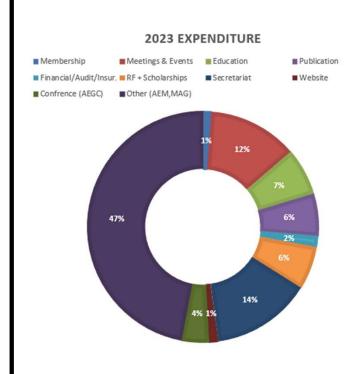

# 2023 Income and expenditure in percentage

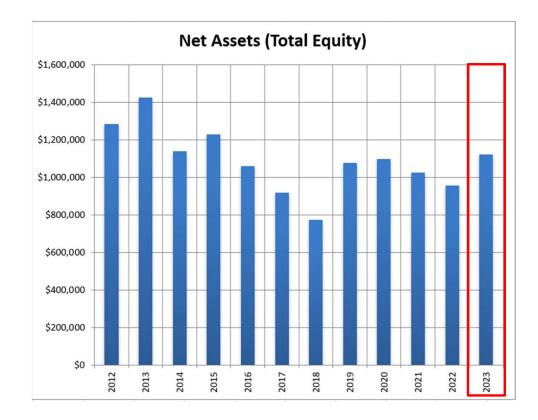
